TITLE: A bill to amend the SGA Constitution to clarify the Presidential veto capacity

Whereas, the Student Senate has the right to amend the SGA Constitution,

Be it hereby resolved, the Student Senate amends Article II, Section 3, subsection k, to read:

“k. To veto those enactments of the Student Senate, the Graduate Student Senate, and the First-Year Council to which they take strong objection.

i. A written message must explain the reasons for a veto and be provided by the President at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the body immediately after and in which the legislation was passed.

ii. A vote of two-thirds of the number present at the meeting can override said veto, provided a quorum is met.”
